**BACKGROUND:**

National Institute of Homoeopathy is a premier institute in Homoeopathy under Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India. NIH was established in the year 1975 and developed as a state of Art. Institute is affiliated to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences, and presently conducts the degree course in Homoeopathy viz Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery [B.H.M.S.] since 1987 and Post - Graduate course i.e. Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy [M.D.(Hom.)] in six subjects viz Organon of Medicine, Repertory, Materia Medica, Practice of Medicine, Paediatrics and Homoeopathic Pharmacy since 1998-99 onwards. NIH has been successfully running OPD and IPD for more than 40 years. The OPD of the institute has been attended by more than 1500 patients every day.

1. National Institute of Homoeopathy, Kolkata invites e-tender from reputed, experienced manufacturers/Companies/Firms/Agencies/bidders for supply of Homoeopathic medicines of SBL/HAPCO/SCHWABE INDIA brand. Manufacturers/Authorised dealer/Agencies having the experience of providing the same service to Central/State Govt./Reputed Private Hospitals or autonomous bodies may send their bids both Technical and financial online.
2. The interested Companies/Firms/Agencies may submit e-tender along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 16,000/= (Rupees Sixteen thousand only) on line through RTGS/NEFT or through Demand Draft in favour of Director, NIH, Kolkata. Bids without EMD will be rejected. It will be mandatory for the selected L1 bidder to submit 5% of the quoted amount as PSM towards security money deposit through demand draft in favor of ‘Director, NIH, payable at Kolkata’.
3. The Bids will be opened on 12/02/2021 at 3.00pm in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who wish to participate in the bidding process. If the opening date happens to be a closed day/holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day.

5. National Institute of Homoeopathy, Kolkata reserves the right to amend or withdraw any of the terms and conditions contained in the Tender Document including quantity/amount of items to be supplied or to reject any or all tenders without giving any notice or assigning any reason. ## **1. Eligibility Criteria**

- i. Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque of **Rs.16000/-**(Rupees sixteen thousand only ) towards EMD. EMD is exempted for MSE's registered as manufacturer of goods and services. In case of online payment details of transaction must be mentioned.
- ii. Copy of G.S.T registration and return certificate.
- iii. Copy of PAN Card
- iv. Copy of IT Returns of the financial years 2017-18, 2018-19& 2019-20.
- v. Last three years annual turnover duly certified from a Chartered Accountant.
- vi. If Manufacturer is directly participating than a copy of valid Drugs manufacturing license with minimum three years consecutive manufacturing experience.
- vii. Bidder should submit a copy of valid “Good Manufacturing Practice” (GMP) Certificate for the last one year for Homoeopathic drugs of the quoted brand.
- viii. Proof of the past experience in supply of Homoeopathic medicines to different State/ Central Govt. Agencies/Institutions/PSU etc.
- ix. Copy of Trade license.
- x. Copy of Homoeopathic drug License issued by competent authority.

## **2. Mode of submission of notice inviting e tender**

- i.The tender shall be submitted online both technical bid and price bid.. URL: [www.tenderwizard.com/TWEPROC](http://www.tenderwizard.com/TWEPROC) in two bid system.
- ii. EMD has to be submitted on line or sacn copy DD shall be up uploaded and hard copy of the same shall reach to NIH before closing date of the bid. Whereas PSM shall be submitted in the form of demand draft in favour of Director, NIH, payable at Kolkata.
- iii.. Detail clarification/information along with documental evidence as sought under eligibility criteria above must be given while submission of the bid.
- iv. Manufacturer's authorization in case bid is submitted by an authorized dealer (A declaration must be attached here in case directly quoted by a manufacturer).
- v. Technical bid and price bid shall be submitted as per the given format in the TWEPROC portal . Please refer Annexure-A for list of medicines and BOQ.
- vi. Bidders are requested not to submit the hard copy of bid. If the hard copy is submitted in physical form, the tender document of the concerned bidder shall be straightway rejected. Scan copies of all the documents are to be furnished electronically.

### **3. Opening and Evaluation of the Technical Bid**

- i. Opening of the Technical bid shall be made by a committee constituted for the purpose in the presence of the bidder himself or his authorised representative in the Store section of NIH on the scheduled date and time as mentioned in the tender. The authorized representative will have to produce the authorization letter of the concerned firm to the Chairman of the Committee at the time of attending the meeting. The absence of the bidder / authorized agent will not debar the committee to open and evaluate the Technical Bid on the schedule date and time.
- ii. The Committee will examine the documents and other allied matters as per eligibility criteria stipulated in the NIT and segregate bidders into eligible and non - eligible category.
- iii. The qualifying bidders in the Technical bid evaluation shall be informed in advance before opening of the price bid.

### **4. Opening and Evaluation of the Price Bid**

- i. Opening of the price bid shall be made by the committee constituted for the purpose in respect of only for those firms who qualify in the detailed scrutiny and evaluation of the Technical bids.
- ii. The Committee for scrutiny of the Tender documents will evaluate the price bid of the successful bidders and also prepare the Price Comparative statement and select the L1 bidder for each item of medicine and to place it before Tender Inviting Authority for approval.
- iii. The absence of the bidder / authorized agent in the said occasion will not debar on the part of the committee to open and evaluate the Financial Bid on the schedule date and time.
- iv. In case of a discrepancy arises between the price quoted in figure and the words, the committee will accept the amount quoted in words as the price of the bidder for that particular item (s) at the time of comparison..

### **5. Finalization of Tender, Notification of Award of Contract and Letter of Purchase/Supply order.**

- i. The Tender Committee will finalise the tender process.
- ii. The Tender Inviting Authority on the basis of the finalization of the L1 bidder will notify the successful bidder in writing by registered / speed post or by email that its bid for the items, which has been accepted through purchase/supply order.
- iii. The successful bidder(s), upon receipt of the PURCHASE ORDER, shall deposit the prescribed Performance Security within 15 days and shall complete the order within 45 days.

### **6. Performance Security:**

- i) Performance Security of @ 5% Purchase Order value to be deposited in favour of Director NIH, payable at Kolkata. Performance Security shall be accepted in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft / Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized bank in India.
- iii) Failure of the successful bidder in providing Performance Security within the scheduled date shall make the bidder liable for forfeiture of its EMD.
- iv) The Performance Security shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier.
- v. The Performance Security shall be returned to the bidder after completion of all the contractual obligations without interest.

## **7. Execution of Purchase Order and supply conditions**

i) The successful Bidder shall not assign either in whole or in part, its contractual duties, responsibilities and obligations to any other party to perform the contract on his behalf.

ii) The successful bidder shall not sub-contract the execution of the contract in any manner.

iii) The supplier will be allowed a maximum **period of 45 days** from the date of issue of Purchase Order to complete supply of all the indented items to the buyer. Thereafter, a maximum period of one month may be allowed for extension on written request with penalty of 0.5% per week or part thereof for the delayed supply and will be charged as Liquidated Damage up to a maximum of 5% on supplied value of particular supply destination and will be deducted from the payment.

iv) The date of manufacture, the date of expiry of each batch of medicine shall be specified.

v) If the supplier fails to complete the supply within the extended period, i.e. within the period of Liquidated Damage, the purchase order will be cancelled, performance guarantee will be forfeited and the supplier will be Blacklisted for subsequent 02(Two) financial years.

**8. Corrupt or Fraudulent practice:** i) No bidder shall contact the Tender Inviting Authority or any of its officers or any officers of the Government on any matter relating to its bid, other than communications for clarifications and requirements under this bid in writing, with an intention to influence the members of various committees or officials of Tender Inviting Authority. Any such effort by a bidder to influence the Tender Inviting Authority in the Tender Inviting Authority's bid evaluation committee, bid comparison or contract award decisions may result in rejection of the bid.

## **9. Force Majeure**

i) For purposes of this clause, Force Majeure means an event beyond the control of the successful bidder and not involving the successful bidder's fault or negligence and which is not foreseeable and not brought about at the instance of , the party claiming to be affected by such event and which has caused the non – performance or delay in performance. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the Tender Inviting Authority either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes excluding by its employees, lockouts excluding by its management and freight embargoes.

ii) If a force majeure situation arises, the Tender Inviting authority is no way responsible for such situation and the successful bidder shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract.

**10. Penalties:** If any information or documents furnished by the tenderer in the tender paper/during procurement process are found to be misleading or incorrect at any stage, the tender of the relevant items or whole tender of the tenderer shall be cancelled and the concerned firm shall be black listed for participating in tender for at least subsequent 2 tender of similar nature in coming years.

## **11. Price**

Prices quoted should be **final**.

## **12.. Delivery**

The items should be delivered within 45days from the date of placement of order.

**13. Payment:** Payment shall be made through PFMS mode after receiving the items in good condition and on the basis of satisfactory report of the user section. Three copies of the bill with bank details along with three copies of chalan shall be submitted.

#### **14. COURT JURISDICTION**

This shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Kolkata, West Bengal.
